Kevin Cogan joined Rotary in 1998, three years before retiring with the rank of Colonel after a thirty-year career in the United States Army. was during this period that Kevin took a keen interest in international water projects after visiting the rural poor in Honduras. He has since made multiple trips and participated in five water and sanitation projects in Honduras and one to Haiti. As District 7390 water and sanitation committee chairman, he created a District 7390 bottled water label to promote awareness for the need for clean water and sanitation projects in third world countries. He contributed a water and sanitation article each month in the District 7390 newsletter. He continues as youth exchange counselor, and was an Assistant Governor. Kevin is a Paul Harris Fellow, a member of the Paul Harris Society, and a Major Donor of The Rotary Foundation. He earned a Bachelor of Science degree from the U.S. Military Academy at West Point and a Masters degree in Electrical Engineering from Columbia University.
