




























VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES

Penalty Card	Explanation of Penalty
	Instruction--Corrective Action is Needed
	Warning of Violation. Corrective Action is Needed or the Exchange will end.

Drinking				Drinking is illegal for anyone under the age of 21 years. If you are at a party where others under 21 are drinking, you will be arrested too.
Drugs				Drug possession and use is illegal. You will be arrested.
Driving				Driving or operating cars, trucks, 4-wheelers, snowmobiles, jet skis, lawn mowers and other motorized equipment are all prohibited.
Sex				Touching the genitals and breasts of another person, and oral, anal and vaginal sex are all prohibited.
Smoking				It is illegal for students under 18 to purchase cigarettes. Smoking cigarettes, cigars, or pipes, and use of chewing tobacco is not acceptable for any exchange student. Vaping or possession of any electronic cigarette or juul is prohibited.
Dating				Romantic involvement with another person is prohibited. Be friends with many people but do not have a boyfriend or girlfriend. Taking a date to homecoming or the prom is permitted.
Disrespect				Examples: 1. Talking during presentations to a group, such as in a classroom or at a Rotary event; 2. Not following your host family's rules, or not joining your host family for meals or activities; 3. Profanity or sexual language or images on Facebook or other social media. 4. Using a cell phone at meals or in the car.
Disfigurement				Hair coloring, tatoos, piercings, and similar changes to your body or appearance are prohibited. How you look when you arrived at the airport is how you will look when you leave.
Devices				Excessive use of computers, laptops, tablets, and cell phones is prohibited. Excessive use means use in class at school, at rotary events (except photos), and in ways that isolate you from your host family and friends.
School Work				Failing grades, failure to complete homework on time, and failing to attend class are examples of violations.
Rotary Activities				Students must participate in District and club activities. Students must respond to email messages to confirm your attendance, even for mandatory events.

Penalty Cards are issued by District Officers. Other warnings may be issued by host families, counselors, or others, but do not count as penalty cards. Except in extenuating circumstances, penalty cards will be issued at least one week apart.
