You **MUST** attend the in-person mid-level competition to move to the finals! Mid-level contestants will be notified by March 25 if they are moving on to the finals. The finals will be held Saturday, April 5, 2025 at 2:00 p.m. at the Hershey Lodge (325 University Drive, Hershey). If you are selected to attend the Finals, **YOU MUST** attend.

**Students are tasked to choose their own topic as the center for their speech and then apply the four principles of the 4Way Test. That is the prompt for 2024-2025!**

Of all the things we think, say or do: 1) Is it the truth? 2) Is it fair to all concerned? 3) Will it build goodwill and better friendships? 4) Will it be beneficial to all concerned?

### **Participation Guidelines**

1. Review the Four-Way Test Speech Contest Guidelines & present your speech to your local Rotary Club.
2. Students who move on from the club level will be invited to participate in the Mid Level Competition. Students must complete the entry form at [www.rotary7390.org](http://www.rotary7390.org) and submit, as instructed, by March 7, 2025.
3. Practice, practice, practice. Speech guidelines & judging overview attached.
4. Entrants will be invited to join ONE of the Mid Level Competitions.
