Plan B Accident & Sickness Benefits

- Accident & Sickness Limit \$1,000,000
 - Deductible \$0 (zero)
 - Paid at 100%

This policy covers you for:

- Accidents; like sprained ankles
- Sickness; such as colds and flu
- Doctors Visits
- Prescriptions
- Emergency room visits
- Labs, Tests and X-Rays
- Inpatient Hospital Stays

Primary Exclusions



This is what CISI unfortunately cannot cover:

- Routine Physicals
- Immunizations
- Routine Dental Care
- Vision exams, eye glasses and contact lenses

High Risk Activities Not Covered

- Bungee Jumping
- Parachuting
- Skydiving
- Parasailing
- Hang-Gliding
- Mount Climbing where ropes or guides are used
- Scuba diving unless you are <u>currently</u> certified
- Operating a motorized vehicles

Additional Benefits



- Allowance of \$500 to cover pre-existing conditions
- Mental & Nervous: \$1,000 for outpatient, \$25,000 inpatient
- Emergency Dental up to \$400 (relief of pain)
- Trip Cancellation up to \$3000 (prior to departure)
- Accidental Death & Dismemberment up \$100,000
- Chiropractic paid up to \$50 per visit up to \$500

- Emergency Family Reunion benefit of \$5000 for flights, meals and hotel if the insured is hospitalized in excess of 4 days and a family member travels to bedside.
- Round trip flight benefit of \$3000 if the insured must return home due to the death or serious illness of grandparent, parent or sibling.
- Trip Delay up to \$500 if delayed for more than 12 hours.
 - Carrier delay
 - Quarantine
 - Lost or stolen passport
 - Natural disaster
 - Traffic Delay due to Accident
 - Carrier Strike
 - Weather





Maximum benefit for Medical Evacuation- \$100,000

- Upgraded seating
- Non-Medical Escort
- Medical Escort
- Wheelchair Assistance
- Transport to and from Airports
- Air Ambulance

Arrangements <u>must</u> be made by CISI



Benefit for Repatriation Return of Mortal Remains-\$50,000

- Embalming
- Cremation
- Minimally Necessary Container
- Shipping Costs
- Necessary Government Authorizations

Depending on the religious beliefs or government authorizations, this process may take time



Security Evacuation Coverage up to \$100,000

- Political or Military Unrest
- Natural Disasters
- Verified Physical Attack or Verified Threat of a physical attack
- Kidnapped or Missing Person

Arrangements <u>must</u> be made by CISI

Personal Property & Liability

- ✓ Personal Liability Limit/Claim \$500,000
- ✓ Medical Payment Limit/Coverage Period \$5,000 (if you accidentally hurt someone other than yourself)
- ✓ Additional Living Expense Limit/Coverage Period \$5,000 (if you damage your host family's home so that it is unlivable this covers your stay in a hotel or other lodging)
- ✓ Unscheduled Personal Property w/Replacement \$5,000 (this covers damage to personal items)
- w/ \$ 250 deductible per claim for all the above



CISI and AXA Assistance Emergency Travel Assistance

AXA Assistance is available for you around the clock! Anyone can open a case on behalf of the insured if there is an emergency.

- Legal Assistance-
 - lets say you are arrested and need a lawyer, AXA will provide you with a lawyer and help you through the process
- Medical evacuation-
 - If you need to be relocated to another hospital or to a hospital back home. AXA will help you with this process
- Multi-lingual services are available-
 - AXA has staff members that are fluent in other languages to assist you while you are abroad
- Guarantee of Payment, GOP
 - AXA will coordinate with the hospital to place a payment
- Assistance with Prescription drug
 - shipment/replacement-AXA will coordinate with the pharmacy to replace your medication (if the drug can not be found abroad)





Important Information about CISI Overseas Health Coverage



In the Case of a Minor Injury or Illness

We are happy to pay a foreign provider directly. Many foreign providers, however, prefer payment from the patient when services are rendered.

- Insureds using this insurance should be prepared to pay for a doctor visits for minor illnesses such as a sore throat or a sinus infection, for example
- > Claim form and itemized bills can be emailed to CISI
- ➤ Claims are typically processed within 15 business days, provided CISI has all of the information needed
- > For minor incidents, we do not need to be notified
- No Network Restrictions!



Important Information about CISI Overseas Health Coverage



In the Case of a Serious Injury or Illness

- ➤ Contact AXA Assistance to open a medical case
- > Provide AXA the location and the students information
- > AXA will contact the facility to issue a guarantee of payment


