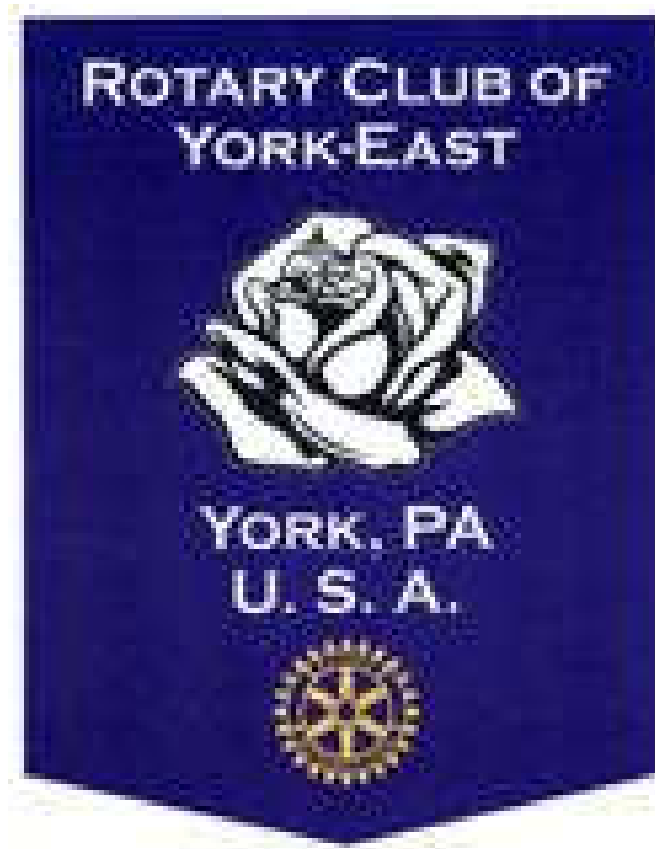

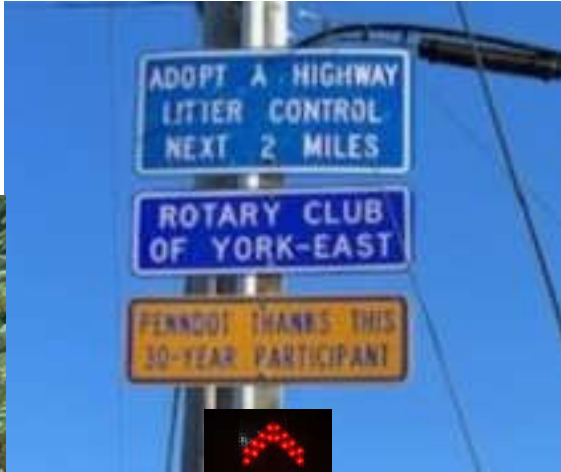

OUR HISTORY

- ★ Began in York, PA in the **1970's** at the York Mall
- ★ Originally headed by the **Pilot Club of York**
- ★ **The Rotary Club** took over around **2013**
- ★ Program moved to East York Elementary until 2010
- ★ In the years following, the program moved around to different schools in the York Suburban and Central York School Districts.
- ★ **Current Home:** St. Joseph's Catholic School of York
- ★ At the Program's peak, there were almost **400 campers** between the 2 sessions.
- ★ Initially, Safety Town included small wooden buildings that were used to construct a literal town.

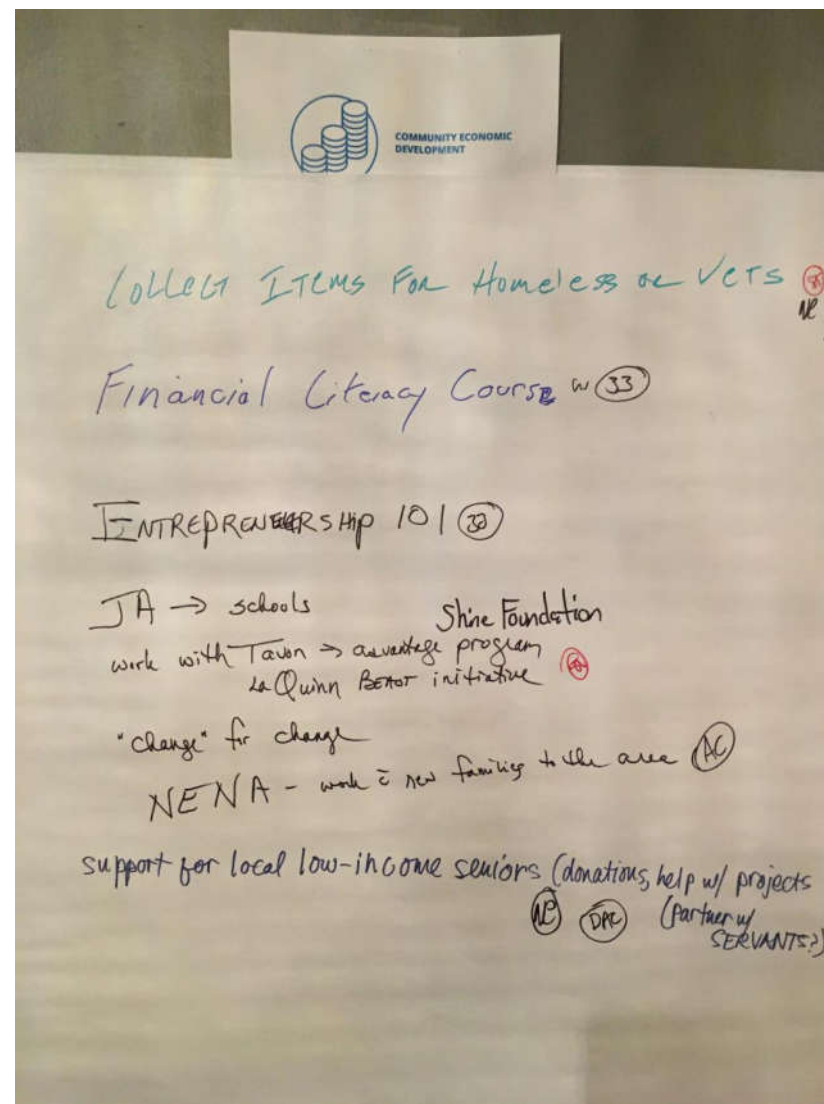
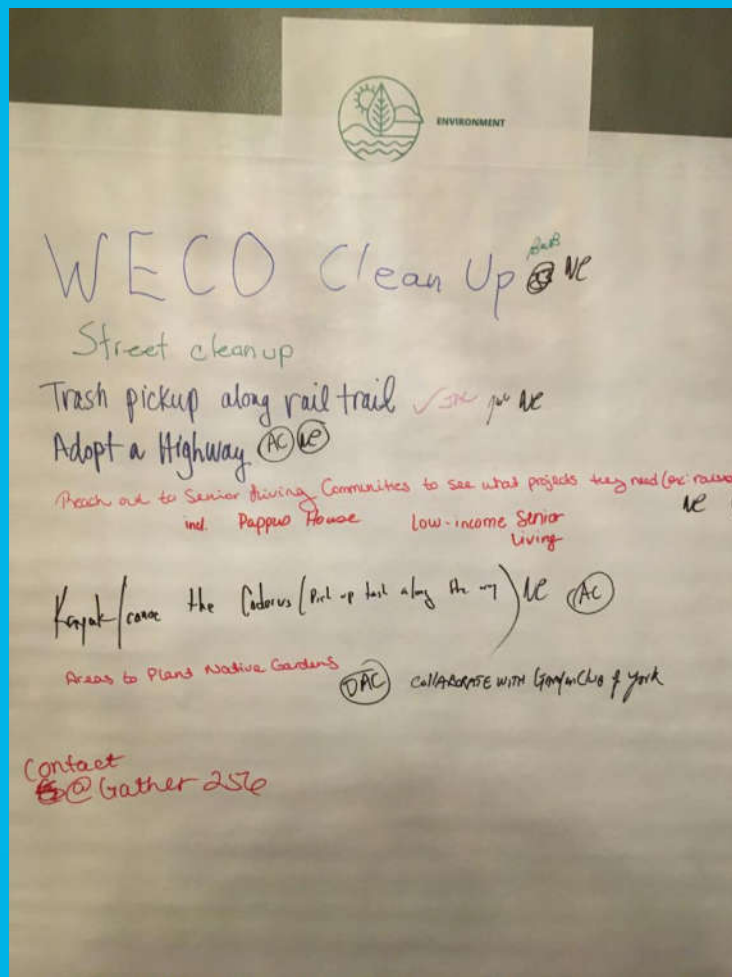
